

Peter Kilkus and Carol Kunze gave a summary of the Pope Valley Economic Development meeting and the issues that concerned the
- 2. Treasurer's Report: Membership and Dues Status: Approximately 51 members have paid their 2006 dues and the Chamber has just over \$1,300

Due to the timing of the original organizing process of the Chamber (it was formed mid-2005) there has been some confusion and overlap of dues requests.  - 6. Road Signposts suggestion: Sharyn Simmons of Cucina Italiana has suggested installing classic signposts at intersections to show people the way to our businesses and recreational opportunities. The idea was wellreceived by the attendees. Information kiosks at locations such as the Corners and Turtle Rock were also proposed, as well as designing a logo specific to Lake Berryessa that would become a recognizable image for the area. All these good ideas will need both funding and volunteers to make them realities.

I'm getting getting ready to put my boat away for the season. I checked my bilge pad and it's really dirty. Can I throw it away in any trash can? L.B.B.

Dear LBB,


Please don't put your used bilge pads in the trash! Throwing dirty bilge pads in the garbage only moves the pollution they've absorbed from the lake to the land. A dirty bilge pad is toxic to the environment, and if the pad goes to the landfill, oil and other petroleum-based fluids can leach into the soil and pollute drinking water sources and wildlife habitat. The best way to dispose of used bilge pads is to put them into one of the specially marked red cans found at the gas docks of any of the seven Lake Berryessa resorts.

Dear Bilgee,

I used a bilge pad for the first time this year, and just put my used one in a red can. It was really dirty. I'm curious: what do you do with those used pads? W.F.

Dear WF.

CRI Recycling Services picks up the dirty bilge pads and takes them to their processing plant where they separate oil, other petroleum-based fluids, and water from the bilge pads. Both the absorbent material from the bilge pads and the fluids it soaked up are recycled. Thanks to you and everyone else who used a bilge pad and recycled them in the red cans. It makes Lake Berryessa cleaner and healthier for everyone. Remember to get a new bilge pad to replace the one you've recycled.







Bald Eagles Overhead

For millennia bald eagles have lived near streams and lakes where fish abound. They are excellent at catching large fish, the main item in their diet during the breeding season. Flying low, they dip to the water and snatch fish at the surface, but can also plunge-dive to catch deeper fish. When they do you will see them power up out of the water, shift the fish to an aerodynamic position, and give themselves a big shake to throw off the water. Occasionally, a fish is so large that the eagle drags it to shore by swimming a sort of "breast stroke." Of course, they can also intimidate an osprey into dropping its catch if the opportunity arises. If a fish is dropped, the eagle can catch it before it hits the water.

Bald eagles usually build huge stick nests high in large trees or snags, and add more sticks year after year, sometimes until the tree branch fails. A pair will stay together for life if possible, but they will seek a new mate if one of the pair dies. After the female lays two eggs, both parents take turns at incubation for the next 35 days. The hatchlings are downy and immobile, but have their eyes open from the start. Both parents then bring food to the nest and tend the young intensively for 70 to 100 days until the nestlings learn to fly. Usually a pair of adults successfully raises one or two young each year. It takes a youngster four to five years to reach maturity, and finding a mate may take time, but they live up to 35 years. Eagle parents only assist their young in obtaining food in their hatch year. After that the parents will drive them away to make room for the next batch of chicks. Tough life!

What contributes to the might and majesty of eagles? Their wingspan is about six feet and the breadth of these wings allows them to soar on thermals and updrafts or to power up with prey or in courtship. Their fierce-looking eyes face forward and have two foveas, or areas of extrasharp focus, in each eye. Their vision is many times sharper than ours. Their sharp hooked beaks are used to tear food, not to kill. The kill is achieved by the force of the attack, or by the penetration of the huge talons. Spiky pads on the toes help hold slippery fish.

Outside the breeding season the diet can include small mammals such as rabbits, but is often made up mostly of carrion, including roadkill. They are able to kill ducks and geese in wetland areas, but many of those may be birds weakened by disease or hunger. Golden eagles are found more in open country, feeding on small mammals, birds, snakes, and occasional carrion.

For several decades, bald eagles were in extreme decline due to DDT in the food chain. The effect of the pesticide on eagles was the production of very thin delicate eggshells. Year after year eggs would be crushed and pairs of eagles were unable to hatch young. The banning of DDT in 1972 in the United States allowed the food chain to slowly become less contaminated. Eagles are re-expanding into their old ranges and in fact, Cache Creek above Rumsey is the largest wintering area for bald eagles south of the Klamath Basin

Where can you see bald eagles? In winter look for them in and above Cache Creek Canyon, Putah Creek Canyon, Lake Solano, Lake Berryessa, and Clear Lake. In early spring many will migrate northward, and our local pairs will seek out their breeding territories and begin defending them. If you're especially lucky you might see courtship displays. In mid-flight they may lock talons and descend in a tumbling series of "somersaults.".

Drive-In Movie Theaters: When Did You Last Go To One?

THE FIRST DRIVE-IN MOVIE THEATER WAS OPENED ON June 6,1933, by salesman Richard M. Hollingshead in Camden, N.J. On the bill was a twilight showing of the British comedy Wife Beware. Hollingshead had worked out the technology with a 1928 Kodak projector that he mounted on the hood of his car and aimed at a sheet. The film was a little-known second-run feature, and the neighbors complained about the noise.

From those decidedly humble beginnings, a U.S. institution was born, one that exploded in the post-World War II automobile culture. The drive-in era peaked in1958, with nearly 5,000 theaters across the U.S. But in 1966, daylight saving time led to summer showings at 9p.m., making the screenings less appealing to families. Air-conditioned theaters trumped steamy summer nights, and by the 1980s, the VCR and cable TV dealt another blow to the ailing industry. By 1995, fewer than 500 drive-ins were left.

But just when it seemed as if the iconic U.S. entertainment form was headed for extinction, a mini-revival began. Fueled by a blast of nostal-gia as well as families tired of spending upwards of \$50 to take the kids to the multiplex, new drive-ins have opened in Texas, Montana, Alabama, Georgia, Pennsylvania and New York, while all over the country, vintage theaters have been renovated. Websites like drive-in.net and driveintheater.com keep afficionados updated about openings and showtimes.

A new generation of movie fans is taking its cue from Hollingshead, fusing modem technology with his old-school concept of a drive-in, creating do-it- yourself outdoor movie experiences. DVD players, digital projectors and iPods have put the technology of drive-in movies into the hands of anyone with a technological bent. In California, the Santa Cruz Guerilla Drive-In collective has combined a love of movies with a mission to reclaim public space by staging word-of-mouth screenings of films ranging from politically subversive shorts to Dirty Dancing, and it has inspired other guerrilla-flick efforts in Portland, Me., and West Chester, Pa. In Berkeley, Calif., Web developer Bryan Kennedy turned his car nto a mobile movie unit, a sort of drive-in that actually drives in, with a DVD player, a projector and an FM transmitter that beams a movie's sound track to other cars. His technology has given rise to the MobMov movement, with chapters worldwide, creating free film venues in any open space. (See ww.w mobmov.org.)

Tuleyome Buys Ireland Ranch

Tuleyome, a local not-for-profit corporation based in Woodland, California, recently purchased the Ireland Ranch from the Ireland family, who are fifth generation Yolo County residents. The 640-acre ranch is located in the Blue Ridge abutting 9100 acres of public lands managed by the Bureau of Land Management as the Berryessa Peak unit. The Blue Ridge, a section of the inner coast range in western Yolo County, runs northwest from Putah Creek to Cache Creek.

The Blue Ridge is a dynamic result of plate tectonic forces that steeply uplifted sandstone and shale rock layers creating beautiful interior valleys, creeks and springs. Oak woodlands, gray pine woodlands, chaparral, riparian habitat, and grasslands are the dominant habitat types and mountain lion, black bear, deer, bobcats, eagles and falcons make their home in the mountain range. The ranch forms the headwaters for Enos, Salt and Pine Creeks and includes the location of the historic Scott homestead.

Tuleyome is working to protect both the wild heritage and the agricultural heritage in the Putah and Cache Creek watersheds for existing and future generations. The Blue Ridge Conservancy is a Tuleyome land trust project that operates to conserve lands in western Yolo County.

"We intend to participate in regional decisions as land owners and stakeholders to fulfill our dual mission," commented Debra Chase, Tuleyome's Executive Director. "Current land uses will continue while we develop a management plan, and we hope to be friends and good neighbors with other Blue Ridge landowners." The Ireland Ranch is currently grazed and seeking organic certification.

Fishing With Dino



Fishing With Sid

I finally made it back to the lake this past weekend. On Saturday Terry and his son Sean followed me in his brand new red "Ranger". I showed

him some good spots to fish. He headed up to Pope Creek to try his luck.

I fished three points and I could see trout about four to six feet down chasing shad. I picked up three bass and it wasn't easy fishing. I trolled from Big Island back to Steele Park and picked up a few trout. Mike from Spanish Flat told me to come by early Sunday morning because the crappie bite was great and be sure to bring a red and white jig.



I got there at 11:30 am he looks at me and says the bite might be over. He shows me where to go and wishes me luck.

My first fish took about two minutes, my second fish took me another minute or two and so it went for five fish. A couple of guys were fishing close to me but were not having any luck or using the right tackle. I introduced myself and asked if they would like some pointers. Divan, who is about thirteen years old, came over and asked me to show him what to do. He was a good student and caught his first fish in about four minutes. After that he was bringing them in almost a minute apart and really enjoying himself. He ended up with seven crappie ranging in weight from 1/4 lb to 2 1/2 lbs. His father used the red and white jig and must have hooked up to a catfish or large bass because the rod bent completely under the dock. Unfortunately he did not land it so we never will know what it was but it was big!!!!

If you would like to catch some crappie I suggest you stop by Spanish Flat Marina and ask Mike or Dino what is the best tackle to use and where are the good spots. In the next few weeks the lake should turn and then the top water bite will be great.

Why Do I Feel Sleepy After I Eat?

The glucose from food causes your body to reduce production of orexins, a class of proteins that is believed to keep us alert. Orexin-producing neurons, which are found in the hypothalamus region of the brain, have been known since 2003 to be affected by glucose levels, but it wasn't known to what extent those levels - and the subsequent suppression of orexins -interfere with alertness. In June, Denis Burdakov and his fellow researchers at the University of Manchester in England reported that even a small increase in blood-glucose levels significantly lowers the orexin-mediated neuron activity in the brain, causing sleepiness. The strong dependence of alertness on glucose levels was surprising, although, Burdakov says, the discovery makes perfect evolutionary sense. "It would be advantageous for animals to stop energy-expending behaviors after they obtained their food, in order to make the calories last as long as possible," he explains.

But all foods are not created equal. According to Burdakov, meals rich in carbohydrates or fats elevate blood-glucose levels and make you more tired; meals higher in protein are less likely to have that effect. So if you want to make it through the workday without nodding off at your desk, eat some meat for lunch.




