Over the years, with the growth and development of the wine industry, the City has become an important business and banking center for the wine industry. The City also receives many visitors as a result of the wine industry and the area's scenic qualities. The main goal of the City is to maintain a small-town atmosphere and to provide quality services to its citizens.

The official population of the City of St. Helena as of January 1, 2005 is 6,006. St. Helena is a full service City and encompasses an area of 4 square miles.

Sonoma County's history. Before California was a state, the Sonoma County area was home to the indigenous Pomo, Wappo, and Miwok peoples. Between 1812 and the 1840s, the centuries-old serenity of the region was ended by the advent of several very dissimilar groups of people.

In 1812, on the north coast at Fort Ross, Russian merchants and soldiers, assisted by the Aleuts, founded the only permanent Russian settlement in what was to become the United States. Eleven years later in 1823, Padre Jose Altimira established the northernmost and last Spanish-Mexican mission in California at Sonoma.

Tensions between the Russians, intent on moving their sphere of influence south from Fort Ross, and the Mexicans in other parts of the county, plus increasing numbers of Americans coming "over the mountains," brought matters to a head.

The Americans led the Bear Flag Revolt of 1846 with the support of Sonoma's General Vallejo. It spelled the end of Mexican rule in California and set the stage for California's entry into the United States in 1850.







Delta plan

Just as the report was being released, the Department of Water Resources said that in 2009, it expects to deliver just 15 percent of the water California farmers and urban users typically request. The main reason for the cuts is the ongoing drought conditions that have drastically reduced the amount of fresh water flowing into the Delta. But even if winter brings more rain and mountain snow, court orders designed to protect endangered fish, including smelt, salmon and steelhead, could continue to curtail the amount of water that can be taken out of

These rulings apply not only to farmers and communities located south of the pumping station at Tracy, but also to Solano and other Bay Area counties that take water from the Certainly Solano County is in better shape than many areas, thanks to its water storage at Lake Berryessa, but less water is still less water. How water should be used -- to supply human needs or to sustain nature -is the No. 1 priority addressed by the Delta Vision Task Force. It recommends legally acknowledging that both water supplies and the ecosystem have equal status in any future Delta decisions. The task force laid out 73 recommendations and six other goals as well, including enhancing the Delta's unique cultural, recreational and agricultural values; restoring its ecosystem; promoting statewide water conservation; building new conveyance and water storage facilities; improving flood protection through emergency preparedness, land-use regulations and levee strengthening; and establishing a better system of Delta governance. The devil is in the details, of course, and certainly there is something in the report to displease everyone involved. And there are hundreds of agencies involved. Which is, of course, one reason every other attempt to coordinate a response to the Delta's problems has failed. Californians can't afford to keep squabbling. The courts are already imposing solutions that aren't palatable. And Mother Nature isn't waiting around either. The climate is changing. The rain and snow that used to come with some regularity are no longer arriving on a predictable schedule, if at all. And if sea levels rise, as predicted, there will be more salt water and flooding in the Delta. A cabinet-level committee is taking comments about the Delta Vision Task Force's recommendations -- the next hearing begins at 9 a.m. Dec. 5 at the CalFed headquarters, 650 Capitol Mall, in Sacramento. It will then make its own recommendations to the governor.





The Bureau of Reclamation - Lake Berryessa

Reclamation continues to provide government services at Oak Shores, Smittle Creek, Capell Cove, Eticeura, Olive Orchard, and other dispersed recreation areas around the lake. While the four west side concession areas remain closed, Markley Cove, Steele Park, and Pleasure Cove Marina remain open for business with boat launching, marinas, camping, RV sites, day use, houseboat rentals, and hotel and cabin rentals.

Reclamation is in final negotiations with Pleasure Cove Marina LLC for the continued operation of the Pleasure Cove concession area as well as final negotiations with Pensus Lake Berryessa Properties LLC for the development and operation of Putah Creek, Rancho Monticello, Lake Berryessa Marina, Spanish Flat, and the Steele Park concession areas. We intend to sign contracts within the next few weeks which will begin the next phase of recreation at Lake Berryessa. Once signed, we expect increasing levels of recreation opportunities around the lake as we approach the 2009 recreation season.
