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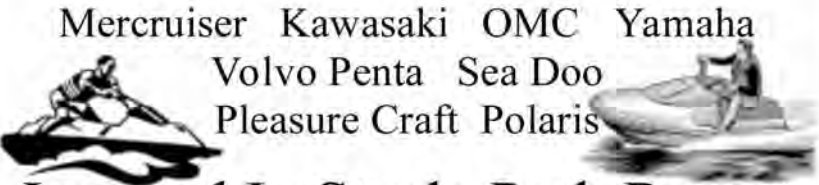

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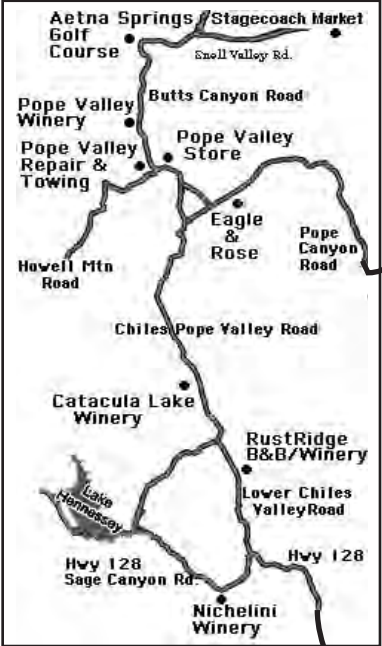

Change of Use Rather Than Eviction?

Although an article about Berryessa For All in the last issue of The Lake Berryessa News mentioned that permittees at Berryessa Marina Resort had received eviction notices, the statement that Rancho Monticello Resort permittees would also soon receive “eviction” notices was premature. Rancho Monticello is contesting several of the BOR contract interpretations and does not believe the term “eviction” is applicable to the “significant change of land use” as defined in the Record of Decision.

Rancho Monticello Resort and all the other resorts at Lake Berryessa were ordered by the Bureau of Reclamation last November to send letters to all permittees giving them a one-year notification of the termination of their permits based on the June, 2006 Record of Decision and BOR Operational Policy #14.

The contract expiration dates for for the various resorts are:

- Berryessa Marina Resort: August 13, 2008
- Putah Creek Resort: August 13, 2008
- Markley Cove Resort: May 26, 2009
- Rancho Monticello: June 15, 2008
- Spanish Flat Resort: July 13, 2008
- Steele Park Resort: May 26, 2009

Pleasure Cove Marina is a special case since all permittees were evicted from that resort last year.

The actual language in the BOR letter states: “all privately owned long-term trailers, mobile homes, and associated personal property currently located within the concession areas will be permanently removed from Federal property...” The letter also states that “This removal needs to be accomplished no later than (emphasis added) the expiration date of the existing contract.” It further demands a plan from each resort and that “The plan should allow ample time for you to assure complete clean-up of each site not later than the expiration date of your contract.”

This last statement is a major point of contention since it requires each resort to eliminate their major source of income (mobile home permit fees) well before the end of their formal contract. This would be a significant financial blow to each resort and could possibly lead to major litigation against the BOR.

The BOR also states that if a removal plan is not submitted for approval to the BOR by January 5, 2007, the BOR will write its own removal plan for the resort. It is unknown whether any resort has submitted such a plan.

Rancho Monticello Resort issued the following statement in response to last week’s story: “Rancho Monticello Resort has no intention of issuing eviction notices until the required 60-day in advance to the termination of our concession agreement or as required by a possible phasing agreement. As required by BOR Operational Policy 14, Rancho Monticello Resort will give tenants a one-year notice for change of use at the appropriate time. We plan to be a very a strong bid-

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der – offering the public improved uses, and meeting new and higher demand. We also expect to provide facilities for all of our current permittees.”

Dear Napa Register Editor (Copy to Lake Berryessa News):

I have read your editorial ("New phase in battle for lake," Jan. 21) as well as the January 17 article regarding the lawsuit filed by Berryessa For All. I was also quite surprised that you printed so many rebuttals against both articles, bravo!

What does Berryessa For All really want? It may seem obvious to the biased. Berryessa For All first and foremost wants equality or an equal voice that will be counted. In your article you state that the process for public review was extensive...that it was - but it was biased. When the bureau asked for public comment and input it did not count all responses equally. The bureau’s count of support for their plan was supposedly in favor of ousting the mobile homes. Task Force 7 members collected over 13,000 signatures from mobile home owners, campers, RV campers, boaters...people from all walks of life in opposition to their plan. Yet, the BOR arbitrarily decided to count those thousands of signatures as ONE COMMENT. Every other comment received in support of the bureau’s biased plan was in fact counted - significantly skewing the data.

A few of your readers have said to the mobile home people “move on.” I have only one thing to tell those callous individuals. The Bureau of Reclamation permitted everyone of those sites, collected fees and for the past 25 years mismanaged Lake Berryessa without any accountability. Two separate government audits called the bureau to question regarding the mismanagement. The only way the BOR can save face is to wipe the slate clean (remove mobile homes and trailers) and start from scratch so that their mismanagement can be conveniently covered. The real shame is that the BOR purveys water well but doesn’t have a clue how to manage recreational venues.

If one could look at the current lake situation with an unbiased eye you would see that with such a large lake—over 165 miles of shoreline—that kayakers, trail walkers, birders, boaters, campers, RV’ers and mobile home owners could all share the lake together in harmony. Again all we ask for is equality.

Sometimes folks that demand equality have to do so with a loud voice. I remember not too long ago the norm was to force people to have separate entrances, seating and not allow them in certain schools. However, some very vocal folks protested and demanded equality and things were changed. As I said, we want an equal chance by an unbiased person to hear our case—then and only then will we receive equality.

People were catching bass in seven to forty feet of water and trollers for trout were trolling in the upper ten feet of the water with needle fish and castmasters behind flashers. Fishing with Dino

Very cold and windy conditions at the lake last week. Bass anglers were doing well throwing Jigs and CrankBaits in 20 to 40 feet of water. Steve Whan of Spanish Flat Resort reeled in a 7.9 lb largemouth on Friday.

Trolling a flasher with a Kastmaster behind it was working well for Trout at 5 to 15 feet of water. Skiers Cove Shoreline is the hot spot. Salmon are at the deeper depths near the dam area. Crappie and Catfish were very slow with the cold weather and winds!

Fishing this weekend was about the same. Water temp. is 49 degrees 8 feet from the surface.

Troll the surface at 7 to 15 feet using a flasher and Needlefish or Kastmaster. Salmon are reported at the dam area a little deeper. Bass anglers are doing well on jigs in 15 to 40 feet of water. Crappie are possible in early morning hours. Use minnows off the bottom. The water is still a little cloudy from all of the winds, but fishing is very good.

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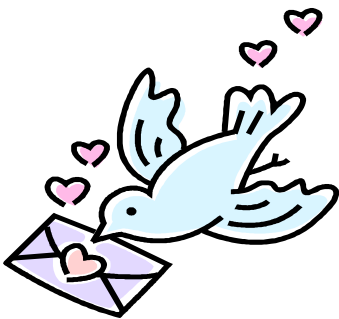

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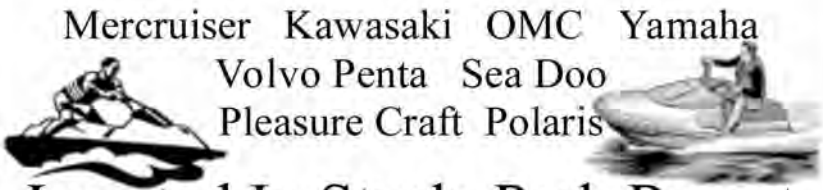

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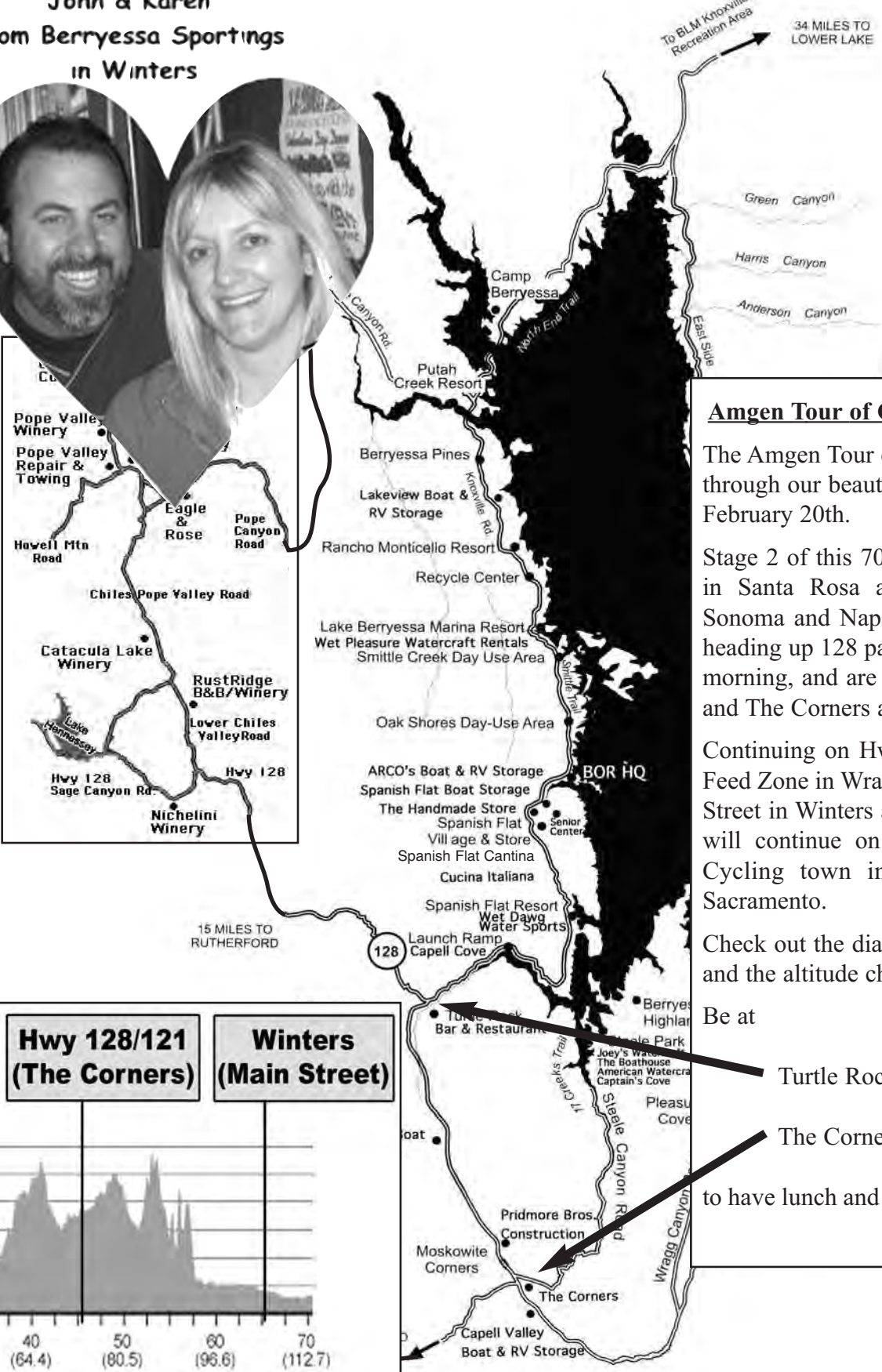

and the altitude changes!

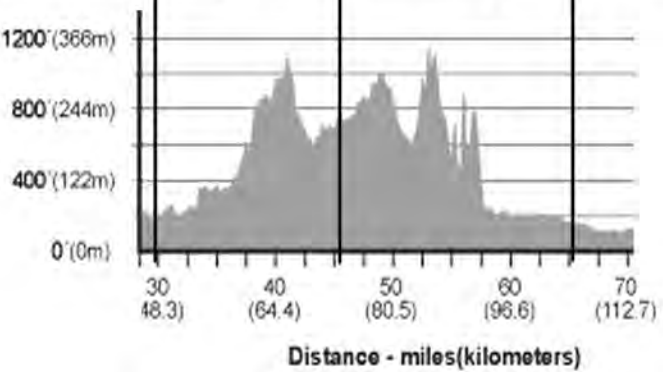

Berryessa Estates Homeowners Pass Bond Measure

County supervisors, acting as directors of the Lake Berryessa Residential Improvement District, voted unanimously to levy a \$5.2 million bond to repair aging water and sewer works at Berryessa Estates at the far norht of the Lake Berryessa region. The district also faces a \$400,000 fine from state regulators.

The district hopes that by showing the state it has the means to fix its infrastructure and prevent future sewage spills, state regulators, and ultimately, the attorney general will back off of their attempts to extract fines and penalties.

The board’s action comes after 348 ballots went out to area property owners, asking for their views. One hundred and eighty five voters responded. The vote is not a one-person, one-vote affair, but takes into account the value of the property each owner controls. The tally showed that those representing about two-thirds of the property values at Berryessa Estates wanted the board to seek the bond.

Under the assessment, each of more than 300 parcels would be assessed more than \$15,400, with the exact assessment depending on the soon-to-be discovered interest rate of the \$5.2 million bond. The sewage and water rates will start to fall to an an average \$1,452 year-ly in March.

Berryessa Trail Design Grant Awarded

The state Coastal Conservancy agency granted \$150,000 to the Berryessa Trails and Conservation group to pursue the design of about 100 miles in trails around the perimeter of Lake Berryessa. The Berryessa grant, in addition to designing new trails around the lake, would also fund improving two already existing trails: the 4-mile-long North End Trail that runs between Putah Creek and Eticurea Creek, and the Smittle Creek Trail that connects the lake’s two public parks - - Oak Shore Park and Smittle Creek Park. There are several gaps in North End trails, many of them caused by erosion including a land-slide. One of the challenges will be trying to construct trails along some of the lake's steep banks between the lake and Highway 128.

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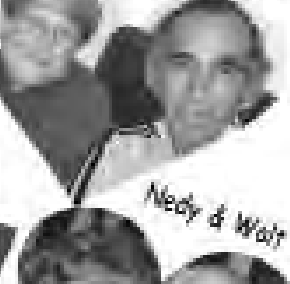

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What's Inside: Powdered Nondairy Creamer

Corn Syrup Solids: Corn syrup is, for the most part, glucose. When it's dehydrated to about 10 percent water, the resulting granules are basically sugar.

Vegetable Oil Solids: Powdered creamer has to get its creamy texture somewhere. Coconut and palm kernel oils are among the heavier food oils and are added - in all their partially hydrogenated glory - for velvety smoothness. Because they add up to less than 0.5 gram of trans fat, the label can claim "zero grams trans fat."

Sodium Caseinate: Casein is a protein found in cow's milk, thus making this nondairy product off-limits to vegans. Officially, it's kosher, but don't go mixing it with meat. (Note to self: no more ground beef in your coffee.)

Dipotassium Phosphate: Also called phosphoric acid, dipotassium phosphate provides the tang in Coca-Cola. It helps us digest sugars, fats, and proteins, which happen to be nondairy creamer's top three ingredients. Oh, it's also a pesticide and a major ingredient in fertilizer.

Monoglycerides and Diglycerides: These single- or double-chain fatty acids end in a glycerol molecule. The glycerol end attaches to water, and the fatty acid end to fats and oils, making these substances gentle mediators between the creamer and the coffee

Sodium aluminosilicate: Known to potters as albite feldspar (a ceramic glaze and strengthening agent), sodium aluminosilicate is used in foods as an anticaking agent. Powdered nondairy creamer is flammable, and if it gets too anticaked (dispersed in the air like a cloud), it can explode. Just one spark, and - kaboom!

Artificial Flavors: Since glucose, palm kernel oil, and sodium caseinate don't really taste like cream, artificial flavors are required. Manufacturers tend to keep exactly what they use a secret. Of course, these flavors can sometimes come in very noncream varieties like hazelnut, amaretto, or mocha.

Annato: This natural pigment from a tropical plant provides a yellow color, so the creamer looks more, you know, dairy-ish.

UNDERSTANDING PERVIOUS CONCRETE

Pervious concrete is a performance-engineered structural material using the usual constituents of Portland cement concrete, only with little or no sand in the mixture, allowing for a 15- to 30-percent air void factor. The decreased density makes the concrete able to absorb stormwater, while still providing a quality structural pavement. A pervious concrete system can be designed with an appropriate porous aggregate base layer to function as a stormwater storage basin for a design storm event. Pervious concrete can be colored or painted, made smooth for shopping cart mobility, and made into a non-slip surface.

U. S. Environmental Protection Agency regulations require owners of newly developed (or redeveloped) sites of 0.4 ha (1 acre) or more to have an on-site management system for treating stormwater. Often, this requires dedicating 10 to 20 percent of the overall site to non-revenue-generating detention/retention ponds and swales or using expensive underground storage treatment systems. But pervious concrete can double as a parking facility and stormwater treatment system.

Pervious concrete handles moisture in excess of 5080 mm (200 in) of water hourly per 0.09 m², translating to 11.4 to 19 L (3 to 5gal) a minute. The design of the aggregate base, sometimes called the recharge bed, is critical to pervious concrete performance and durability. The percolation of the soils, combined with infiltration rate dynamics is important, especially where freeze-thaw durability is a concern.

Contrary to traditional concrete (where larger sizes and angular-shaped aggregate frequently provides the best performance) smaller aggregate and rounded shapes appear to not only provide the best porosity for pervious concrete, but also better strength, smoothness and appearance.


