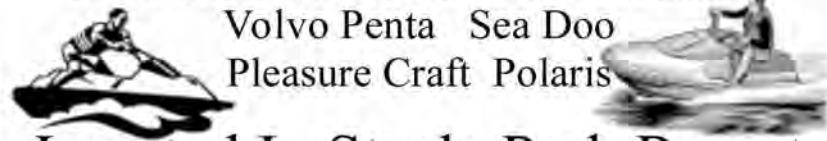

Big Fish record shattered!

Nobody that has ever fished one of the Future Pro Tour's past four season openers on Lake Berryessa would have ever doubted that a double-digit largemouth bass would be caught by some angler pre-fishing for the fifth opening season event on March 24 at Spanish Flat Resort. But few - including Jason Milligan and Michael Wright - would have ever imagined there would be a fish brought to the scales during competition that



would set an all-time big fish record for an FPT event.

"I'm still shaking from the experience", said a wide-eyed jubilant Michael Wright, who was responsible for netting the **14.89 pound** largemouth. "We had about 13 pounds at about noon, and were looking to upgrade, as we knew 13 pounds would probably only put us in the top ten", he added. "We decided to start throwing big swimbaits with the hopes of catching a big one and when we saw that fish come out of the water we new we had it won".

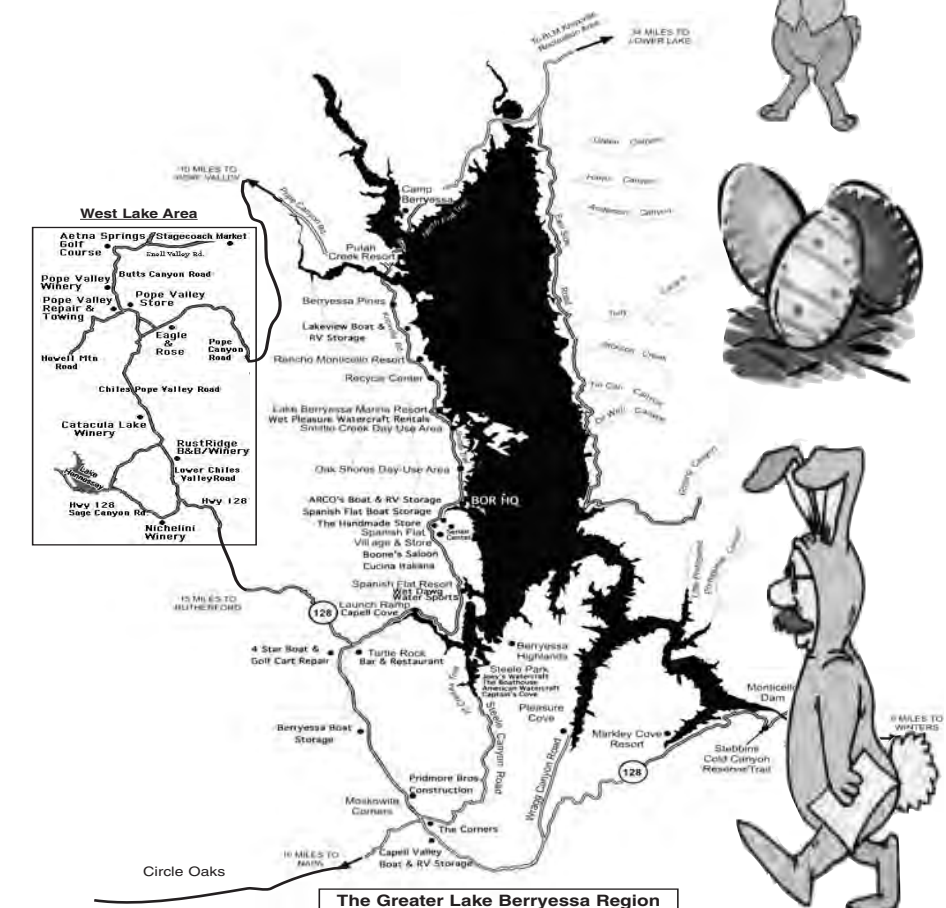

What’s In: Fix - a - Flat?

Sticky, stinky gunk that’ll keep you rolling a few more blocks.

TETRAFLUOROETHANE

A type of fluorocarbon that doesn't deplete the ozone layer, TFE is found in everything from cryogenic tissue kits to car air conditioners. Here it's used as a tire inflator, a drying agent, and a propellant for the other ingredients. Unfortunately, it's also a green house gas that's been implicated in abnormal testicular growth in rats you must have some serious cojones to keep using it.

HEAVY AROMATIC SOLVENT NAPHTHA It's not called aromatic because it smells (though it does - like petroleum). Aromatic is a scientific term referring to any molecule with one or more hexagonal rings of six carbon atoms. They can be unusually stable and powerful solvents for other hydrocarbons. Since naphtha is a mixture of medium-weight aromatic rings in the C9-to-C16 range (extra carbon atoms can hang off the sides of the main structure), it easily dissolves smaller carbon compounds like simple plastics but won't harm larger polymers like styrene-butadiene (synthetic tire rubber).

AROMATIC RESIN

Aromatic hydrocarbon resins are sticky substances made almost exclusively of C9 monomers (small molecules that can join with other molecules to form polymers). They are commonly used as epoxies and adhesives and, like naphtha and amorphous polyolefins (below), they are found in partially distilled crude oil. Usually all these substances would be further processed and separated, but keeping the resins, naphtha, and polyolefin together works like magic here. How so? Read on.

AMORPHOUS POLYOLEFIN

In the can, this shapeless mass of polymeric olefins (low-density plastics like polypropylene and polyethylene) remains dissolved in the heavy aromatic naphtha. But once Fix-a-Flat is sprayed into the tire, the plastics coat the inner surface and plug the leak. Then the sticky aromatic resins keep them in place. The TFE dries the resins and polyolefins, and you drive to the nearest service station to get your tire repaired.

I had a very productive fishing weekend a week ago. On Friday my wife and I headed out mid-morning to the east side of the lake. Where we had planned to start fishing there were boats pre-fishing for the "Future Pro" Tournament. So instead of starting at our usual point we went on the side across from the point. It was a very good decision. The bottom was hard ground and grass, fairly shallow with an access to deep water. We fished the ridge and by the time we came to the point, we had a limit. We fished it again and caught a few more. Most of our favorite spots were being fished so we headed towards the vineyards hoping it wouldn't be too packed with boats. When we got there it was pretty empty so we set up in eight feet of water and positioned the boat to drift with the breeze. We landed some nice size bass. Again my wife used her favorite brass and glass with a senco (with great success she landed five bass on her own) while I used various tackle but landed most of my fish with plastics. Our total weight for the best five fish for the day was fourteen lbs. three ounces.

On Saturday we left at about the same time. The water was a lot rougher and the wind had picked up. We decided to fish in the Monticello Ski Club cove hoping it would be sheltered from the wind. The total weight for that day for five fish was ten pounds one ounce. Of the total 160 boats that were in the "Future Pro Tournament" the winner weighed in five fish for a total of twenty-two pounds!!!!!! One bass weighed fourteen pounds!!!!!!!

Sunday I thought I would stay by the dock and relax. I saw a small boat fishing in the marina with three people on it. Of course I asked them how they were doing and they said they had no luck I asked if they would like to follow me and I would show them where the fish are and hopefully how to catch them. I took them to one of my favorite coves and showed them the tackle that had been working well for me and my wife all weekend long. The two guys had a double hook-up but the bass were under-size. Then I picked up a two pound bass.

Going to about four feet of water I gave May a minus one lure that only sinks down to a foot and she trolled it behind the boat. She got a bite and brought it to the boat. It was a bass and she was so excited that she left slack in the line and you guessed it the fish spit it out. Learning the first lesson, she tried again and caught a trout which she brought to the boat and picked it up and it shook free. She had a few more hits and finally was able to land a trout. As we were heading back to the Marina, I threw out a "Lucky Craft" similar to a rattle trap and let her hold it. She yelled out that she was stuck and I said no it's a fish we are in deep water She reeled in a two plus pound bass and this one made it into the boat. She is now hooked on fishing!! 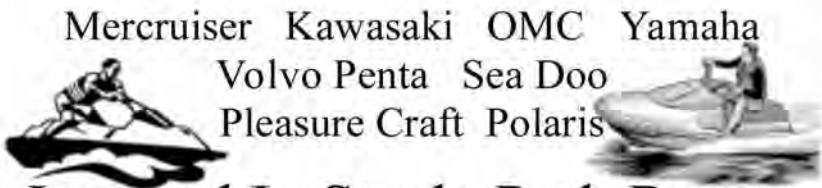

Berryessa Shoreline Getting a Clean Look for Summer

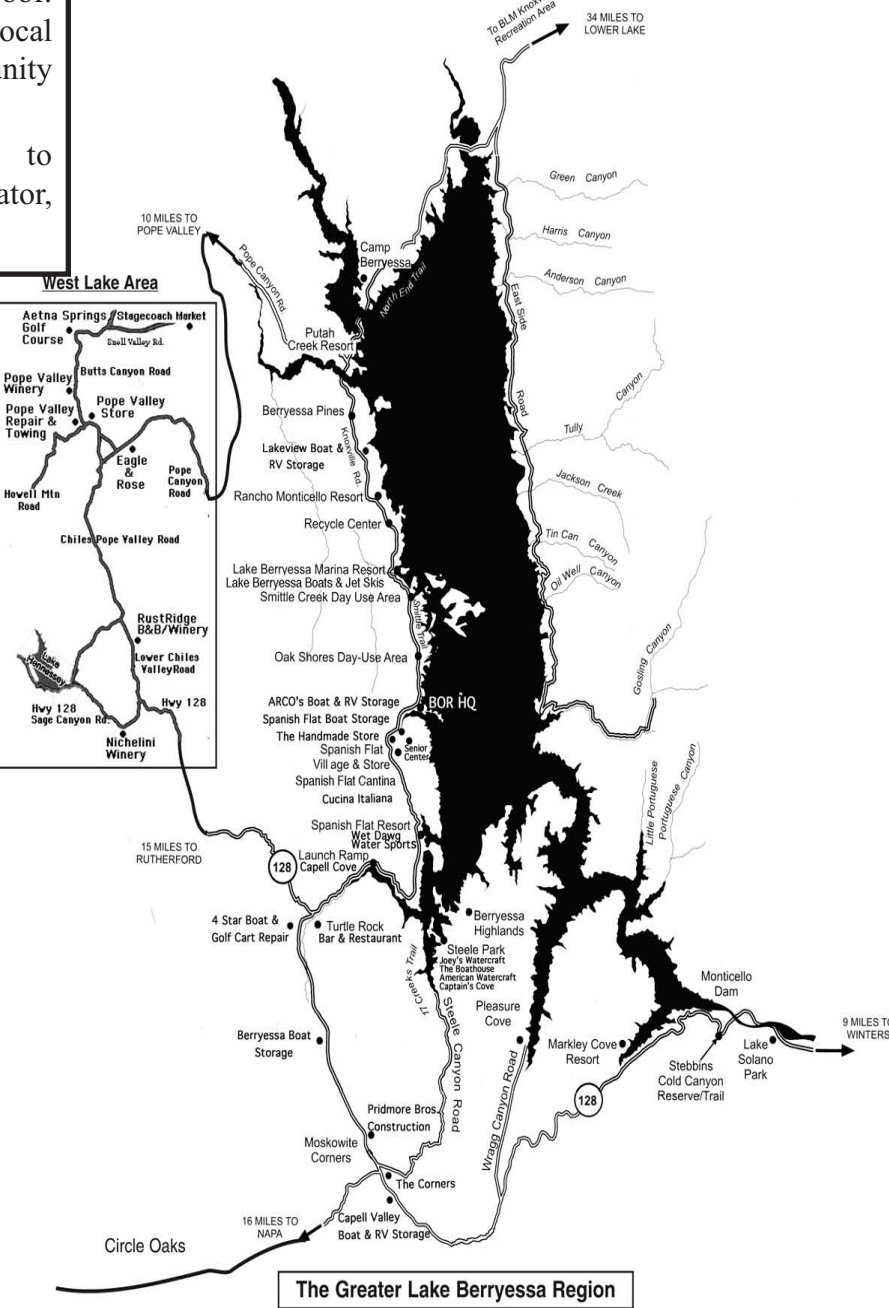

Firewise kicks off 2007 Wildfire Awareness Season

With the onset of the 2007 wildfire season, Napa Firewise celebrates its third year as a community-based fire prevention program. The program is designed around the life-safety needs of county residents living in high fire risk communities like Angwin, Deer Park, Dry Creek/Mt. Veeder, Pope Valley, Berryessa Highlands and Circle Oaks.

The goal of Napa Firewise is to raise the awareness in the community to the dangers wildland fire poses and to provide the knowledge and tools necessary to survive. April is not too early to begin defensible space planning and construction. The law requires a 100 foot defensible space zone around your home or structure as the minimum. While sometimes difficult to achieve,

there are ways to accomplish this goal. If you have any questions about defensible space regulations or construction, visit the Firewise Web site at www.co.napa.ca.us., or call the Napa Firewise hotline at 967-1426.

To make defensible space easier to achieve this season, Napa Firewise is once again offering a free chipping program to county residents. The big change in this season’s service is that we will provide chipping all season long. You can deposit as many piles as you like from May 1 to August 31. To sign up for this year’s chipper program and/or a free defensible space evaluation, we have created an online form on the Firewise web site.http://www.co.napa.ca.us/firewise/index.html. Those without internet access can call the Firewise line at 707 967-1426 to leave their information.

•Contact Napa Firewise at 967-1426, e-mail us at napafirewise@co.napa.ca.us, or visit our Web site at www.co.napa.ca.us/firewise to register. Leave your name, phone number, e-mail address, mailing address and parcel (APN) number, and chipping site address if the pile location is not the same as your mailing address.

•Maximum individual pile size is 20 feet long by 6 feet high by 10 feet deep. Multiple piles are acceptable. Materials to be chipped should be left at the public road location with cut ends pointing toward the access road.

•The chipper will only take stock that is between 1/2 inch to 6 inches in diameter. The chipper will not accept vine materials such as poison oak, blackberry bushes, garbage or materials that will bind the chipper. Chipped vegetation will be left on the ground for decomposition.

This service is not intended for general land clearing. For a list of locations where chipping is available, visit the Napa Firewise Web site at www.co.napa.ca.us/firewise and click on the chipping tab. The Web site also contains information on how to obtain a free (\$100 value) defensible space evaluation of your home

What's In: Neutrogena Face Lotion?

Vitamins, ultraviolet light absorbers, and a soothing dab of flesh-eating acids.

HYDROXYACETIC ACID

Marketers prefer the less-scary sounding "alpha-hydroxy." It's a corrosive acid that breaks apart the outer layer of skin, spurring new cell growth. While it may make you look younger, it can also make skin twice as vulnerable to sun damage - good thing Neutrogena adds SPF 15 sunscreen. When hydroxyacetic acid is not melting faces worldwide, it can be found in bathroom tile scum removers, where it dissolves minerals left behind in your shower.

BENZOIC ACID

A derivative of toluene and oxygen, benzoic acid is a preservative commonly used to keep soda or fruit juice from getting moldy. In lotion, it functions as an antimicrobial.

BENZOPHENONE

Rub this flower-scented lotion on your skin - or stick your face in a diesel's tailpipe, where benzophenone is present in the exhaust. Either way, you get a nice sunscreen. If swallowed or inhaled, though, the substance may disrupt hormones and mess with your brain. Scientists - and probably industry lawyers - recommend against using it on kids.

PANTHENOL

This is the alcohol variant of pantothenic acid, aka vitamin B5. In a living cell, it becomes a component of coenzyme A, which helps repair the skin's plasma membranes. Attention Chernobyl-area residents: It also protects against gamma radiation from nuclear fallout.

RETINYL PALMITATE

Nonchemists call this vitamin A, which benefits bone growth and night vision when it's ingested. Here it fights acne and other skin disorders.

ASCORBIC ACID POLYPEPTIDE

You know it as vitamin C. In lab tests, ascorbic acid generated an eight-fold increase in the production of collagen, which helps prevent wrinkles. It's also a powerful antioxidant that neutralizes free radicals (highly reactive molecules that can damage the skin's surface).

OCTYL METHOXY-CINNAMATE

Another sunscreen ingredient, this compound absorbs light in the 280- to 320- nanometer range, the ultraviolet-B part of the spectrum. This type of blocker is a fairly recent addition to lotion - the ozone layer used to stop UVB rays.

XANTHAN GUM

This natural additive gets around more than Paris Hilton. It provides a smooth, pillowy texture in just about everything - from toothpaste and ice cream to rust dissolver.

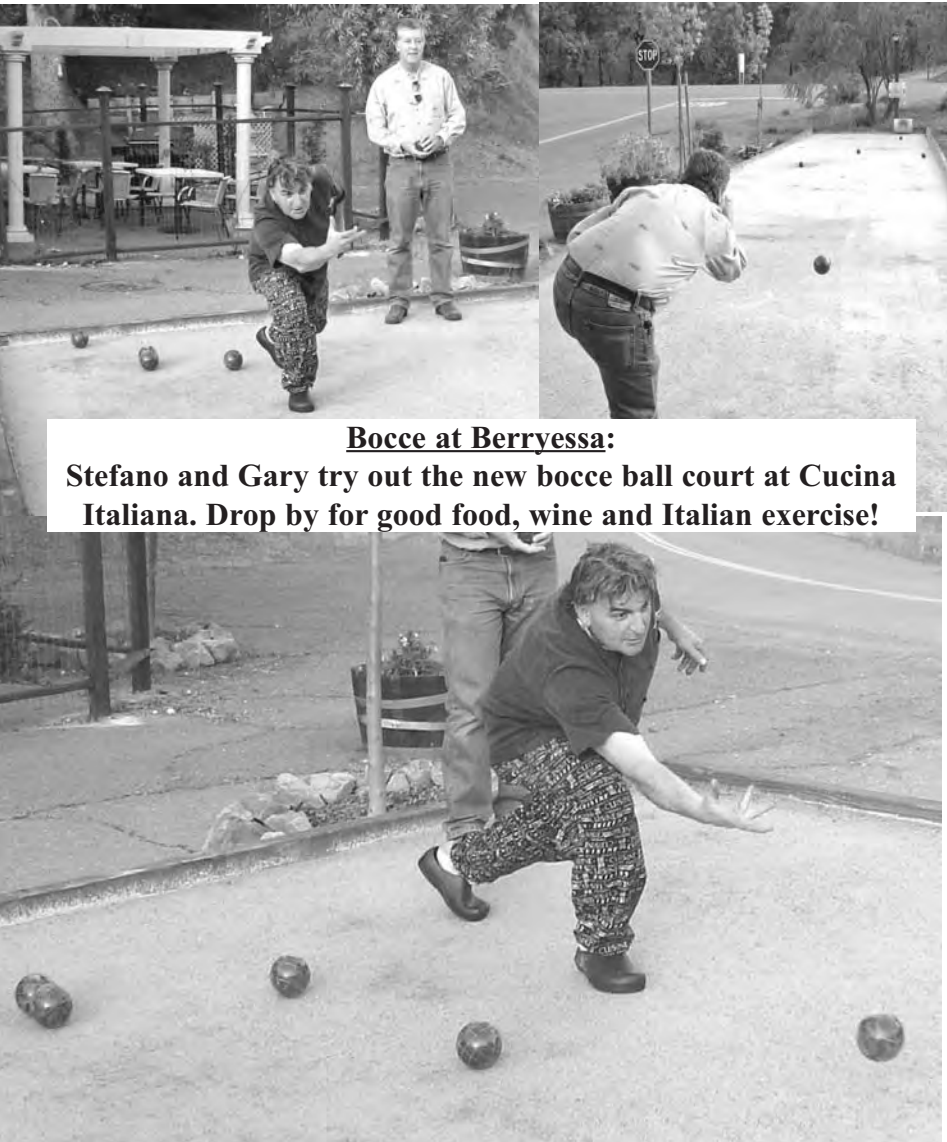

Lots of Crappie coming in to Cappell Cove area near the brush and trees. Use Red & White Jigs off the bottom. Early mornings are the best for Crappie!

Troll for your Trout using Needlefish or Apex this week. Reports are surfacing up to 25 feet from the surface. Skiers Cove shoreline still is the hot spot. Water temp is 58 degrees, 6 feet from the surface.
