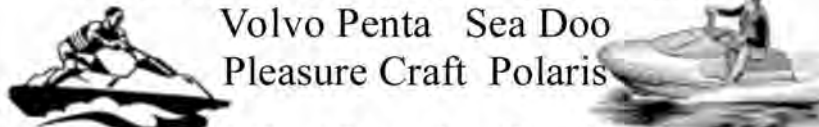

Bilgee and Me:

DeAnna Kamber's Travels with the Happy Berryessa Bilge Pad

Although she may seem to be a new face up at the lake, Lake Berryessa is full of wonderful summer memories for DeAnna Kamber, the new Lake Berryessa Watershed Partnerships's Summer Intern. She grew up in Dixon, and the lake was always a refuge (even sneaking off from school to avoid fifth period algebra on a 100 degree day). She spent most summers with her family at Rancho Monticello, boating, knee boarding, skiing, rock jumping at Pope Creek, camping and wading at any spot they could find off of Hwy 128.

DeAnna is still enjoying the lake but now by talking to people every weekend about protecting Lake Berryessa's great water quality. DeAnna's job is to provide educational materials to local and out of town lake users. Although she's met and spoken with many friendly people at every resort during the last five weeks, there may be some confusion about her frequent companion - what appears to be a giant pop tart handing out small pillows.

That big pop tart is actually Bilgee, the Protector of Clean Waterways (See photo on front page). His mission is to promote the four-year old Bilge Pad Exchange Program run by Napa County Environmental Management and supported by the Lake Berryessa Watershed Partnership, a collaboration of agencies, non-governmental organizations, and private citizens dedicated to Lake Berryessa water quality. The small pillows are bilge pads, and every inboard motor should have one in its bilge to keep oil and engine fluids out of the lake. They hold about a quart of spilled oil and should be recycled after use. Bilgee also promotes the Water Protector Program, a voluntary program for people of all ages who pledge to protect lake water quality.

DeAnna can be found walking around one the seven resorts any Friday, Saturday or Sunday, and she invites everyone to come up and say 'hi.' You can sign the Water Protector Pledge and receive a beautifully embroidered patch, grab a bilge pad, ask about the program, ask about where to recycle your used oil and bilge pad, ask a water quality related question, or share your thoughts about Berryessa water quality and outdoor activities.

Check out the informational kiosks found at each of the seven resorts for all kinds of water quality and water safety information. DeAnna is distributing a lake users' survey (also available at resort entrances) and asks you to fill one out.

DeAnna's summer message to us all is: "Simple actions make a huge difference!"



From the Editor

As the details of the Bureau of Reclamation’s extremely destructive plan for Lake Berryessa begin to sink into the consciousness of those involved, reactions range from extreme anger at government stupidity and duplicity to a deep sense of loss. Imagine the stroke of a government pen crushing your future hopes and past memories, destroying forever the value of your home, and at the same time presenting you with a \$10,000 bill for its demolition! Since a Task Force 7 survey showed that more than half of the mobile homes at Lake Berryessa are owned by senior citizens, this is a financial crisis for them.

One of the first things mobile homeowners should do is to stop paying property tax to Napa County. The BOR’s Record of Decision effectively dropped all property values to zero. If you pay property tax on your mobile home, you should immediately call John Tutuer, Napa County Assessor (707-253-4466, jtuteur@co.napa.ca.us), and request that your property tax be eliminated. In fact, since the BOR planning process effectively destroyed mobile home and trailer property values at least three if not five years ago, you should request a rebate of the property taxes you have already paid for the last five years.

Another patently unfair result of the ROD is that the present resort owners will be paid fair market value for their property if they lose the future bidding process. (Of course, this was already the law, but the BOR tried to violate it originally.) But mobile home owners will receive no compensation for their loss nor any assistance in demolishing their homes. Very few can be legally moved from their present locations, even if there were buyers for these 1,100 units. This situation needs to be remedied.

The following letters represent the present state of affairs. The Task Force 7 Goodbye Letter was sent to all mobile home owners and the hundreds of supporters who have been involved in this process. Dozens of letters of thanks and support were the result. The second letter is from a new group, Berryessa For All, which is investigating all legal options and promises to take strong action in the future.

GOODBYE LETTER FROM TASK FORCE 7 - July 25, 2006

Dear Members,

As of Sunday, July 9, 2006 the Board of Directors of Task Force 7 at Lake Berryessa formally disbanded the organization. The mission it took on five and one half years ago was to challenge the Bureau of Reclamation’s determination to remove long term sites from Lake Berryessa. We used every resource available and with your tremendous support gave them a tough – and unexpected – fight. But the Bureau of Reclamation had been waiting a long time for the end of the contracts to finally accomplish their goal – to rid the lake of long term sites. And, make no mistake, they never had any intention of considering a

compromise - no matter how reasonable. Only congressional help could have brought about a different outcome, but while telling us he was neutral, Congressman Mike Thompson was firmly aligned with the BOR.

You will soon be hearing about at least one – and maybe more – groups that are in the formative stages as we write. In the meantime, any possible legal challenge affecting the removal of our sites (and possible compensation for their destruction) is being thoroughly researched. Neither Peter nor I will be taking a role in any future group but, if asked, will assist them to the best of our ability.

We were blessed for many years to be able to enjoy a very unique place that filled a very special need – a beautiful, warm water lake that was ideal for children and their parents and grandparents to play in. And you didn’t even have to be rich! It is not often that middle-income folks can have a little piece of the best that life has to offer – secure in our knowledge that our presence did not prevent others from enjoying it also.

We thank you all for your support. So make the best of the time you and your families have left – it was great while it lasted!

Berryessa For All

“The Fight for Fairness and Equality at Lake Berryessa”

As the 50th Anniversary of the creation of Lake Berryessa nears, the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation (BOR), on June 2, 2006, adopted the Visitor Services Plan Record of Decision (VSP ROD). The BOR plan mandates the permanent elimination of long-term uses by stakeholders (permittees). Without any compensation and solely at the stakeholders’ own cost and expense, BOR’s plan orders the relocation and removal (demolition in most cases) of all trailers/mobile homes. BOR’s unilateral action ends a rich tradition of recreational and leisure activities and valuable contributions to the local socio-economic community made by several generations of law abiding Lake Berryessa families. Why did the BOR’s plan focus its tunnel vision to reward select interests, including the resort concessionaires and houseboat rental operators, to the detriment and expense of stakeholders who have loyally supported Lake Berryessa for nearly half a century?

The goal and objective of Berryessa For All is to protect and preserve stakeholders’ rights by challenging the BOR’s actions at Lake Berryessa. Berryessa For All will concentrate its fight against BOR at Lake Berryessa utilizing a three-prong strategy: 1) Education of the general public and stakeholders about BOR’s plan; 2) Public relations (court of public opinion) and political awareness campaign regarding BOR’s actions; and 3) Legal challenge against BOR’s actions (e.g. BOR’s “arbitrary” and “capricious” conduct and “abuse of discretion” in the VSP ROD administrative process). 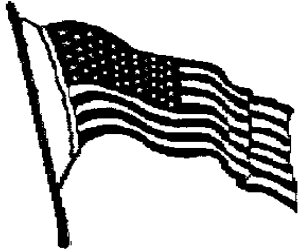

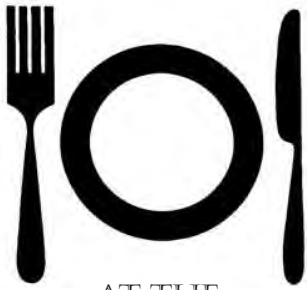

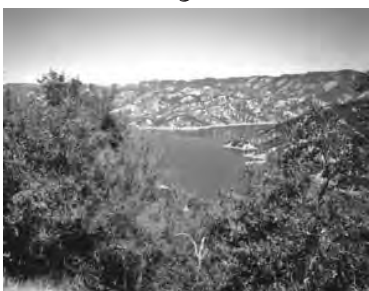

**Joint Pain & Arthritis: Either we have it or will experience it later

If you have joint pain or tenderness, you may be tempted to avoid regular exercise, but **exercise actually can help relieve your pain.** It also can strengthen muscles and tissues around the joints, providing more support for weakened or damaged joints. You can improve your fitness, flexibility, and outlook on life with an exercise program.

Have Fun When you work out!

Studies show that if you participate in a program that is appealing, you are more likely to stick with it. If you enjoy group activities, check out community programs. You may want to try country line dancing or ballroom dancing. Join a yoga class or play golf with friends.

If you prefer exercising on your own, you may want to include walking, hiking, weight lifting, or riding a bicycle. Use a stationary bicycle if you are worried about keeping your balance or falling. Water exercises are great, too. The water provides resistance, helping to build muscle, and the buoyancy reduces stress on your knees, hips, and spine so you can work out without worry of injury.

Just remember: Starting an exercise program is difficult for anyone in the beginning; however, if **you choose activities that you enjoy** and do a little bit every day, the program should get easier with time. Your doctor may recommend that you speak with a **physical therapist, occupational therapist, or orthopedist** for further assistance in designing an exercise program that is most appropriate for you.

1. **Stretches, yoga postures**, or any exercises that encourage you to move your joints normally in all directions.

2. **Strengthening Exercises**

Strength training develops muscles that help keep your joints stable.

3. **Endurance exercises** strengthen the heart muscle, expand lung capacity, and increase stamina. They not only can help you to exercise longer but also can improve your sleep, help you manage your weight, and help improve your sense of well-being.

After a good workout, reward yourself by relaxing in a spa, where the warm water from jet nozzles will massage and relax tight muscles.

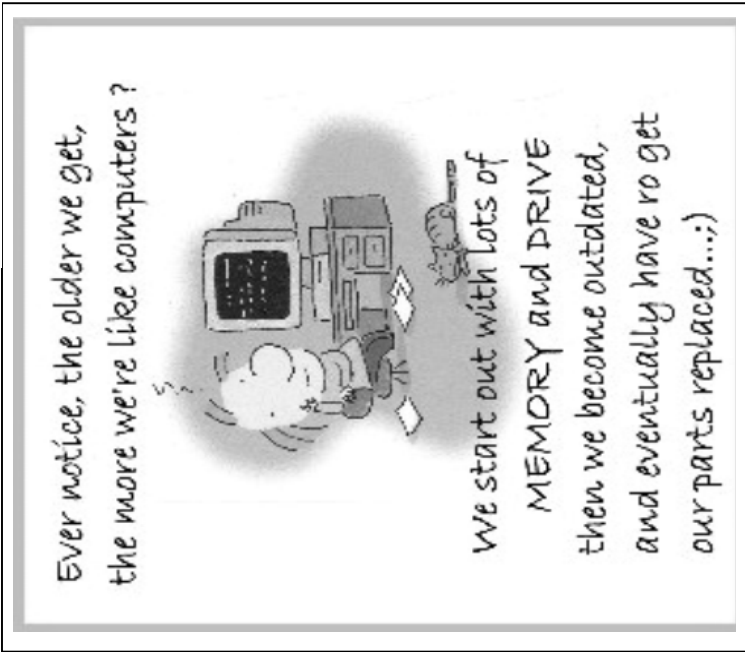

Place the bags into boiling water for exactly 13 minutes.

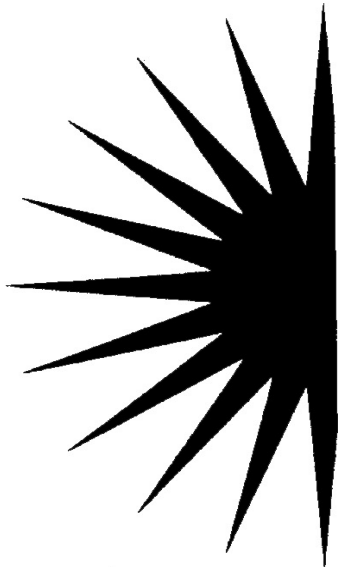
You can usually cook 6-8 omelets in a large pot.

Noxious Weeds and Killer Snails Invade the Berryessa Watershed

Humans have brought thousands of plants and animals into the United States, both accidentally and on purpose. Some of these invade wildlands, destroy habitat, displace native species, and cause millions of dollars of agricultural damages. Invasive species cost the United States more than \$138 billion a year. Several invasive species are present in Lake Berryessa's watershed. Plants include Arundo (giant reed), tamarisk, Himalayan blackberry, star thistle and several annual grasses. They reduce agricultural crop production, impede flows in creeks and streams, reduce flood conveyance capacities, and displace native trees, shrubs and grasses that provide crucial habitat for many fish and wildlife species.

One invasive animal causing great concern is the New Zealand Mud Snail (NZMS). The NZMS is a tiny mollusk that rapidly reproduces, reaching concentrations of 700,000 per square meter. NZMS can strip an entire river system of algae, displacing virtually all other bottom-dwelling species, including caddis, stone and mayfly larvae many native fish species depend on. The NZMS has been found in Putah Creek, endangering the stream, its fish and all waterways connected to it.

The NZMS has no known enemies on this continent. When eaten by most North American fishes, the snail is able to close its shell and pass through the digestive tract of the fish unharmed. In New Zealand, the snails are kept in check by parasites and fish adapted to preying on them.

What can you do?

- Clean your fishing, swimming and boating gear with hot water and/or bleach after every use to kill NZMS and prevent their transfer from one water body to another.
- Never introduce a fish, plant or wildlife species to a new location – there's a reason it isn't there – and the unintended consequences could be disastrous.
- Remove invasive species from your property, your local Weed Management Area or Conservation District can help you with this.
- Don't create patches of bare or open ground during construction or recreational activities, these sites are an open door for invasive plant species.
- Plant native grass, shrub and tree species whenever and wherever possible!

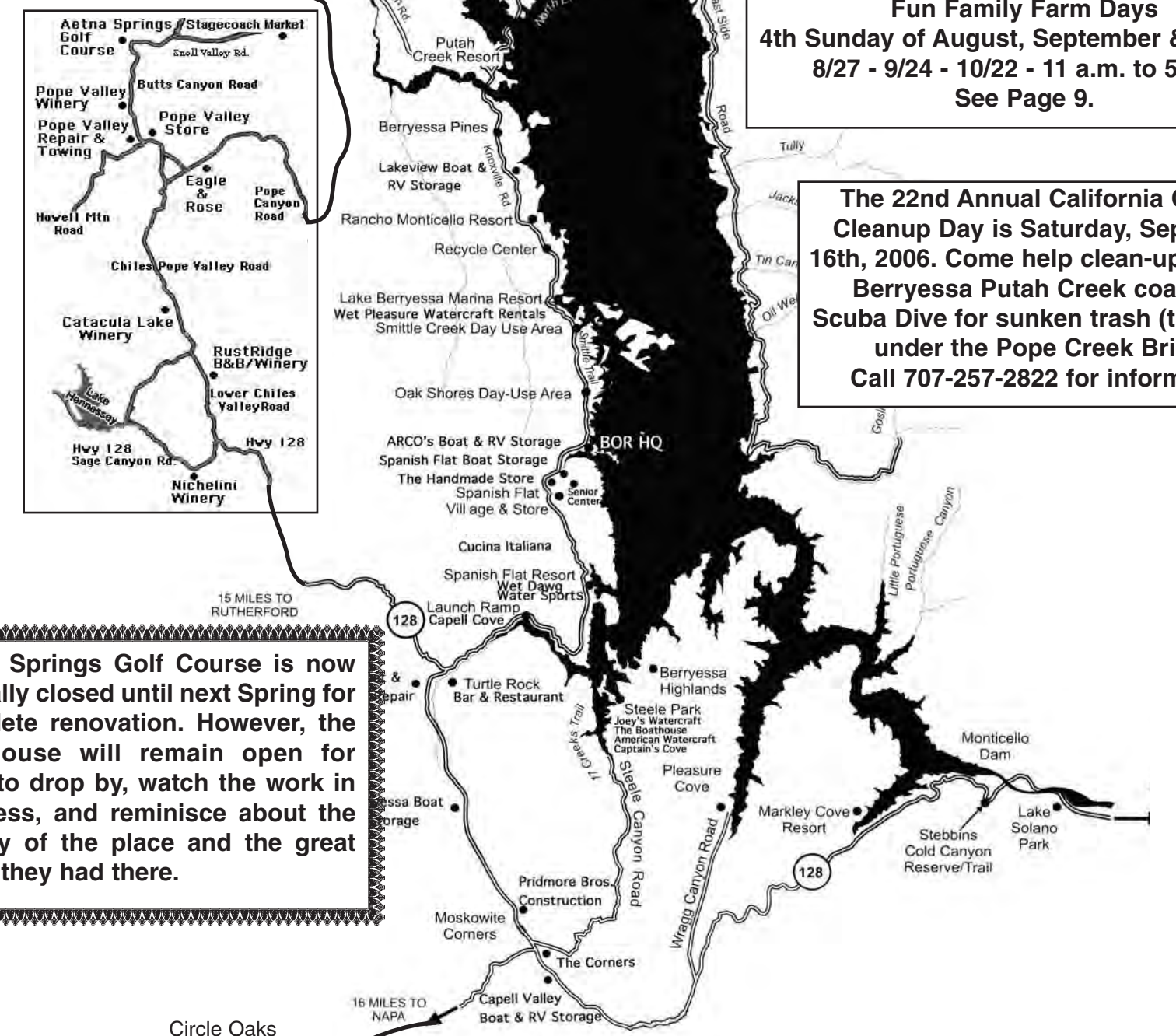

I am glad to be back fishing at Berryessa. I had expected great success this past Saturday but it was not to be. I took Gary out for the day and was all gung-ho for a great day of fishing and we ended up with a day of wishing. Our day started at 6 AM and we were ready for that early morning bite but low and behold....no fish!!!!!!



It was completely still, no birds, no tell tale signs of fish anywhere to be seen. We saw boats trolling for trout and salmon near Big Island but three boats that we spoke to had no luck yet either. We fished from the ranch house to the vineyards throwing everything from

top water to worming the bottom to no avail. We went to Big Island and half way there I made a u-turn because I found the birds in 65 feet of water. Since I was not lucky with bass I thought we should try our luck with trout or salmon. I spotted fish at about 25 feet down so I had Gary throw out a rattletrap shad color and "pow" he hooked on to a 3# bass as he was bringing it in the bass kept jumping and about the fourth jump just inches from the boat.....you guessed it he spit the hook out of his mouth!!!! Gary was not happy.

This became the blueprint for our day. Next we went to shallow water and I fished with two rods. On one I had a live minnow going down about 3 feet in six feet of water, the other I had a weightless Senko. As I was playing the worm, I saw this 4# bass engulf the minnow and take off my rod bent in half and the 4# test line snapped. We went back to

the dock at around 5PM and as I helped Gary to his truck we saw a 3# bass swimming under the docks so I got a rod with a small hook only and put a minnow on it and showed Gary how to lob it so that the minnow will swim and hopefully the bass will go after it.

Success...the bass took the minnow and started to swim, I told Gary do not try to lift the bass out I will go get the net and try not to let him jump, keep the tension on the line. When I got back with the net about 18 seconds later Gary felt bad that he had lost the fish again. Even though we didn't catch fish he and I had a great day trying. After Gary left I stayed at the dock and using the same system caught some bass and catfish.

Sunday I went out for a few hours by myself. I went towards Capell and fished the left side where it's rocky and has trees with no luck. I tried the drift again using a minnow and a plastic crawdad and the minnow won three times. This was a very hard week for fishing. When I came back to the dock I saw my friend Tony and he said he had no luck. Three more people I spoke to had the same results. I have noticed as I walked up and down the docks that the bass were hiding in the shadows of the dock. Each summer there is always approximately two weeks where the fishing is very slow. 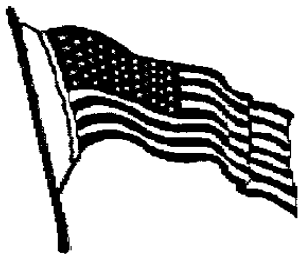

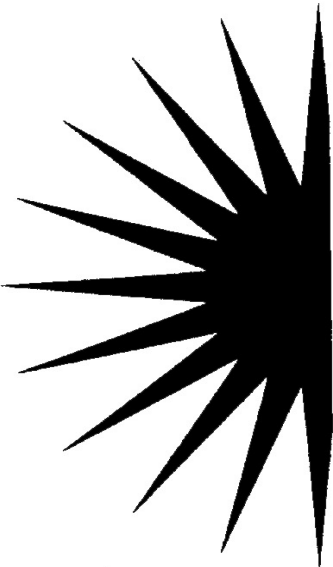


